CRIME.

Crime figures for the period 5th February to 12th February are up from 13 crimes reported last year to 22 this year.

These include: -

One drugs warrants executed by the team in Clowance Street, amphetamine recovered, one street stop and search in Ker Street, one person arrested for possession of heroin.

Two burglaries in Granby Street bet. 7th & 8th Feb. when property stolen includes a laptop, digital camera, computer monitor, MP3 player and jewellery.

A robbery in Devonport Park at about 3.40pm on Tues 9th Feb. mobile phone stolen by two youths asking for the time. (Similar to crime reported last week).

Arson - in the early hours 12th Feb. fire started in Clowance Street flats in a disposal chute.

Anti-social behaviour incidents recorded in the same period in 2009 were 8 compared with 14 for this year
