CRIME.

Crime figures for the period 22nd January to 29th January 10 are down from 16 crimes reported last year to 9 this year. These include 2 burglaries:-

- 1. A flat in Morice Street was entered on Weds 27/01 between 1630 & 2330 hrs, cash stolen.
- 2. A flat in St.Thereses Court was entered on Weds 27/01 between 1300 & 2100 hrs, cash stolen.
- 3. Assault see below.

Anti-social behaviour incidents recorded in the same period in 2008 were 16 compared with 13 for this year.

SERIOUS ASSAULT 24 JAN 10, CLOWANCE LANE, DEVONPORT.

An incident occurred in the afternoon of Sunday 24 Jan when a male was stabbed in Clowance Lane, police were quickly on the scene and the alleged offender was later arrested.

Police believe that this was an isolated incident and there is unlikely to be a reoccurrence.
