CRIME.

Crime figures for the period 25th September to 2nd October are down from 19 crimes reported last year to 18 this year.

These include: -

Theft of pedal cycle from Raglan Road overnight on 25th Sept., described as a men's Carrera with drop handlebars, black and yellow in colour.

Burglary dwelling from a flat in Marlborough Street between the 24th & 26th Sept. laptop, Xbox and games stolen.

Burglary at Hamoaze House during the afternoon of 28th Sept. laptop stolen.

Theft from car (Red Nissan) at Madden Road overnight 30th Sept. car radio stolen.

There have been four arrests for possession of drugs (cannabis and heroin) in the last week.

Anti-social behaviour incidents recorded in the same period in 2008 were 25 compared with 16 for this year.
