DEVONPORT

Crime figures for the period 2nd October to 9th October are up from 12 crimes reported last year to 14 this year. These include: -

Two arsons in Clowance Close and Clowance Street, both on Sat. 3rd, minor damage caused, enquiries to identify offender in hand.

Criminal damage – Flat window in Granby Street smashed at approx. 5.15pm on Sunday 4th October.

Theft from motor vehicle, a white Nissan van parked in Ker Street on Fri 2nd, at approx. 4.30pm, window smashed and satnav stolen.

Two drugs seizures of amphetamine and cannabis.
