CRIME.

Crime figures for the period 18^{th to} 25th September are the same as last years, at 14 reported crimes.

These included six burglaries and two thefts from motor vehicles details as follows: -

Three burglaries at sheds in Granby Green, between 18th & 19th Sept. tools and cycle equipment stolen. One burglary from premises in Cumberland Street between

19th and 21st Sept. Laptop stolen.

One attempt theft from a black Ford Fiesta parked in Richmond Walk between 1300 & 1700 hrs. on 19th Sept. window smashed.

One theft from a blue Citroen parked behind the Devonport Playhouse, Fore Street between 1930 & 2150 hrs. on 21st Sept. 10 disc CD player stolen.
