CRIME.

Crime figures for the period 28th August to 4th September are up on last years, up from 11 crimes reported last year to 17 this year.

There were a variety of crimes, none too serious, including seven assaults, two drug offences, two criminal damages and two thefts.

Anti-social behaviour incidents recorded in the same period in 2008 were 17 compared with 13 for this year.
