Robbery – This occurred at about 3pm on Fri 10th July in a stairwell at Clowance Street when a male was threatened and cash stolen, suspects are three males aged 17-20yrs.

Anti-social behaviour incidents recorded in the same period in 2008 were 14 compared with 25 for this year.
