CRIME.

Crime figures for the period from 23rd July to 30th July are down from 15 crimes reported last year to 12 this year.

These include 2 assaults, 3 criminal damage, 1 burglary, 2 thefts, 2 drugs offences and 2 others.

Of note:-

The burglary occurred at a 2nd floor flat in Clowance Street on Sat 25th July between 7.30pm and 12.05 am Sunday. The flat was entered and cash and radio/CD player stolen.

One criminal damage was in Washbourne Close when a window was smashed at approx. 10.55pm on Weds. 28th July.

One theft involved the theft of a shopping bag containing a 'Henry Hoover Toy' from a bus stop in Granby Street at 2.20pm on Weds. 28th July.

The 2 drugs offences recorded were as a result of positive police action taken in the area..
