## CRIME.

Crime figures for the period 19<sup>th</sup> June to 3<sup>rd</sup> July are down from 37 crimes reported last year to 32 this year.

Crimes include: Assault x 7
Burglary x 1 - see below
Criminal Damage x 7
Drugs x 5 - see below
Theft x 2
Others x 10

The burglary occurred at a house in George Street, when the rear garden was entered overnight on 30/06 and garden furniture stolen, including a wooden table and chairs.

Drugs - one warrant executed by the team and 4 proactive stopchecks carried out resulting in seizures of cannabis and heroin.

Anti-social behaviour incidents recorded in the same period in 2008 were 38 compared with 37 for this year.
