CRIME.

There has been a slight decrease in crime in the last week, 29th May to 5th June down from 21 crimes last year to 17 this year.

Crimes include: -

Assault x 3 (3 x arrest)
Burglary x 1, further details below.
Criminal Damage x 3
Possession of cannabis x 1 (1 x arrest)
Theft from boats x 2
Other theft x 3

Burglary – This occurred at a property in Tamar Street on Weds 3 June between 1230 & 1430 hrs., an Xbox and games were stolen.

Anti-social behaviour incidents recorded in the same period in 2008 were 14 compared with 13 for this year.

Crime prevention – in the fine weather it is important to keep doors and accessible windows closed when you are out and the property is unoccupied.
