CRIME.

There has been a decrease in crime in the last 6 days, 15th May to 21st May, down from 17 crimes last year to 12 this year.

Crimes include: -

Assault x 2 (1 arrest)

Arson x 1 (3 arrests)

Burglary x 1 (1 arrest)

Criminal Damage x 2 (1 arrest)

Theft x 3

The arson took place at Devonport Park on the evening of Sat. 16th May, when a shed in a Council owned flower-growing unit was set alight causing considerable damage. Firemen had to pull a gas cylinder from the blazing shed. Anyone with information about the incident is asked to call the police on 08452 777444, quoting log number 962 of May 16.

Anti-social behaviour incidents recorded in the same period in 2008 were 17 compared with 6 for this year.
