CRIME.

There has been a slight decrease in crime in the last 8 days, 21st May to 29th May, down from 16 crimes last year to 15 this year.

Crimes include: -

Assault x 3 (1 arrest)

Arson x 1, further details below.

Burglary x 1, further details below.

Criminal Damage x 4

Drunk & Disorderly x 3 (3 arrests)

Robbery x 1, further details below.

Arson - This occurred on a third floor landing of a flat in Granby Street when a chair was set alight at 0500hrs on 25th May, the fire service attended and put it out, inquiries are ongoing.

Burglary – This occurred at Prospect Row between 0630 on 26th and 2100hrs 27th May when a property was entered and jewellery, a kareoke machine and Nintendo WII were stolen, inquiries are ongoing.

Robbery - This occurred in George Street between 2100-2115 on 21st May when a male was assaulted and rucksack stolen, inquiries are ongoing.

Anti-social behaviour incidents recorded in the same period in 2008 were 22 compared with 19 for this year.
