## Devonport

### CRIME.

Crime figures for the period 6<sup>th</sup> November to 13<sup>th</sup> November are down from 20 crimes reported last year to 10 this year.

These include: -

One theft from motor vehicle a white transit van parked in Granby Street overnight 6/7<sup>th</sup> November, window smashed to gain entry and large number of CD's stolen.

A drugs warrant was executed in Cannon Street, one person arrested and a quantity of heroin seized.

Anti-social behaviour incidents recorded in the same period in 2008 were 13 compared with 8 for this year.
