CRIME.

Crime figures for the period 11th to 18th September are down on last years, from 20 crimes reported last year to 17 this year.

These included seven burglaries and two thefts from motor vehicles details as follows: -

Two burglaries at Brickfields sports centre changing rooms, both during the day on the 11th and 17th September, personal items including a mobile and jewellery stolen.

Three burglaries from wooden sheds in Granby Street between 18th and 19th September tools stolen.

Two burglaries from premises in Cumberland Street, between 28th Aug and 18th September, cash and camera stolen.

Theft from motor vehicle- at Brickfields during the evening of 16th Sept. window of white van smashed, Satnav and personal computer stolen.

Anti-social behaviour incidents recorded in the same period in 2008 were 10 compared with 22 for this year.
