## DEVONPORT

#### CRIME.

**Crime figures for the period 11<sup>th to</sup> 18<sup>th</sup> September are down on last years, from 20 crimes reported last year to 17 this year.** 

These included seven burglaries and two thefts from motor vehicles details as follows: -

Two burglaries at Brickfields sports centre changing rooms, both during the day on the 11<sup>th</sup> and 17<sup>th</sup> September, personal items including a mobile and jewellery stolen.

Three burglaries from wooden sheds in Granby Street between 18<sup>th</sup> and 19<sup>th</sup> September tools stolen.

Two burglaries from premises in Cumberland Street, between 28<sup>th</sup> Aug and 18<sup>th</sup> September, cash and camera stolen.

Theft from motor vehicle- at Brickfields during the evening of 16<sup>th</sup> Sept. window of white van smashed, Satnav and personal computer stolen.

Anti-social behaviour incidents recorded in the same period in 2008 were 10 compared with 22 for this year.
