CRIME.

Crime figures for the period 7th August to 14th August are below last years down from 18 crimes reported last year to 13 this year.

The burglary occurred at a flat in Cumberland Street during the day on 13th August. The front door was forced and Xbox, games, DVD's and 4ft Samurai sword stolen.
