CRIME.

Crime figures for the period 14th August to 21st August are below last years down from 13 crimes reported last year to 9 this year.

Crimes include: - 2 x Burglary as follows: -

1. Flat in Gun Lane Tues. 18 Aug. bet. 2.00 & 3.00 p.m. via a window – cash and Nintendo DS console stolen.
2. Flat in Washbourne Close Thurs. 20 Aug. bet. 7.00 & 7.30 p.m. 2 x flat screen TV's, 1 x 16inch and 1 x 42 inch, cash and jewellery stolen.

Drugs- 2 arrests during the week for possession and cultivation of cannabis at a flat in Granby Street.

Anti-social behaviour incidents recorded in the same period in 2008 were 10 compared with 19 for this year.
