**CRIME.**

**Crime figures for the period 31<sup>st</sup> July to 7<sup>th</sup> August are well below last years down from 19 crimes reported last year to 4 this year.**

**Crimes include: -**

**Assault x 1 a domestic incident.**

**Criminal damage x 1, car damaged at Locks Walk by rocks thrown over wall from Garrison Close on 5<sup>th</sup> August.**

**Drugs x 1, arrest for possession of heroin Mount Street on 5<sup>th</sup> August.**

**Theft of pedal cycle x 1 from Devonport House between 1<sup>st</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> August, described as men's 'Storm' black mountain bike.**

**Anti-social behaviour incidents recorded in the same period in 2008 were 21 compared with 11 for this year.**
